

First Reading: Isaiah 49:14-15

The city of Zion laments that God has forsaken it. God replies that a mother would not forget her baby. Yet even if she did forget, "I will never forget you."

Second Reading: 1 Corinthians 4:1-5

Paul describes himself as a servant of Christ. He explains that the opinions of other people are unimportant to him. God is the only one worthy to judge us. When God returns, he will praise those who deserve it.

Gospel: Matthew 6:24-34

Jesus warns the people not to waste their time worrying about material things. He says that God provides for the birds in the sky. "Are you not more important than they?" Jesus asked. We should not worry about food and clothes. Instead we should act as God wants us to, then he will help provide for us.

St. John Paul II Scholarship

The Knights of Columbus Saint John Paul II Scholarship is open to all graduating high school seniors registered at Our Lady of the Mount Parish. The scholarship was initiated in 2005 under the guidance of Msgr. Benwell, former Pastor of Our Lady of the Mount.

In honor of Pope John Paul II the scholarship started at \$500, and is awarded to an outstanding OLM graduating student. Requirements are parish membership, grades, and activities - in church and the community.

Over the twelve years of existence there have been a total of fifteen scholarships awarded. With the generous support of the OLM parish family at our Annual Pasta Dinner, the award has increased to \$1,000.

Applications will be available after Easter with a closing date at the end of May. The award will be presented at the Knights of Columbus Council meeting in June.
